Important information about your stay

The interior living space is surprisingly spacious. We have full central heating on board so passengers should always be cosy even in the coldest of winters and further electric heating is also available throughout the boatel if required. Any level of catering can be accomplished in the superbly equipped black gloss galley kitchen. The two beautifully dressed double cabins are compact but offer the ultimate in luxury and comfort.

Please bear in mind that living on board any vessel is unlike being land bound in a flat or apartment. Floor space is tight within the cabin areas so our advice would be to travel light and avoid hard case luggage for storage purposes. There is no floor space within the cabins for a cot but we have a portable cot available which can be set up in the lounge and used in conjunction with our baby monitor. Recessed child sized bunk beds are located in the stern measuring 2' 6" x 5' 4" (suitable for 10 years and under). There is a double sofa bed in the lounge to accommodate larger groups.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE USE OF THE TOILET FACILITIES:

All our wastewater drains directly into the canal, hence the need to use the eco-friendly products supplied. Toilet waste is contained on board and is disposed of weekly by the crew. Nothing other than human waste may be disposed of in the WC. Paper must be put into the bin provided. The shower is ceramic, 24 inches square and hot water is supplied by means of a water heater which takes just a few minutes to reach the required temperature. The ceramic WC on board The Four Sisters Boatel is the latest model in boating technology with touch panel flush.

IMPORTANT

The toilet drains into a septic tank located in the engine room. The tank has a capacity of 280L and is emptied weekly.

Toilet tissue etc should be disposed of in the bin provided. Extra disposal bags are in the WHB cupboard.

Absolutely <u>nothing</u> other than human waste may go into the WC. Any toilet tissue, wet wipes, cotton wool/buds or sanitary products <u>will</u> break the macerator.

It is recommended you flush only when necessary to preserve septic tank volume and water supply.

If you do not adhere to the above, this will result in the unfortunate closure and cancellation of reservations on the Boatel for at least four days whilst awaiting replacement parts/repairs. The loss of revenue will be calculated at a modest £100 per day and must, unfortunately be passed on to the last guests on board The Four Sisters.
